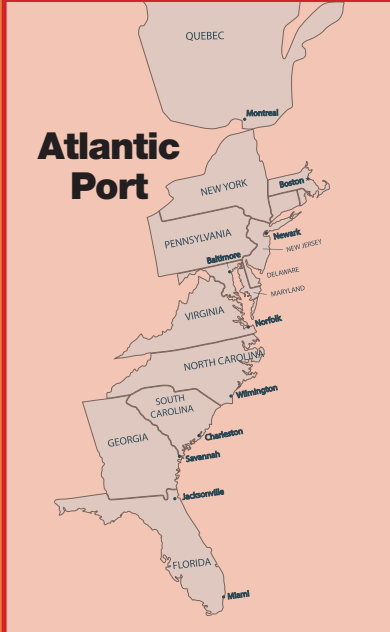

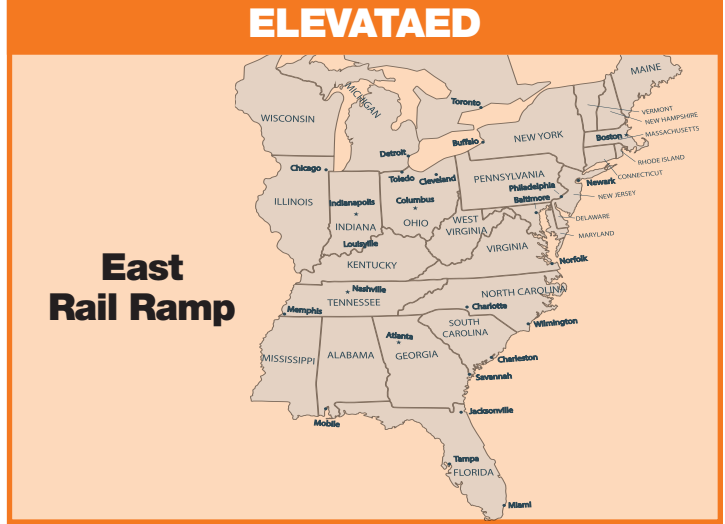
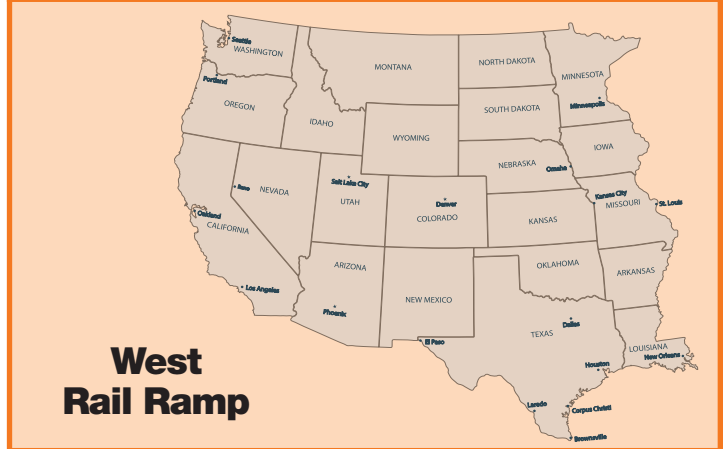

OCEAN/DOMESTIC CONTAINER RAIL RAMP OPERATIONS

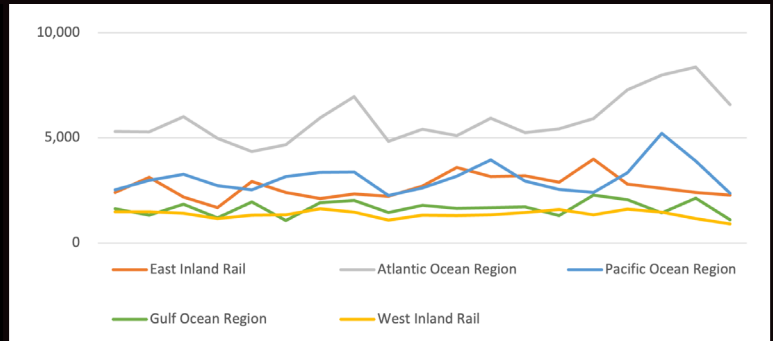
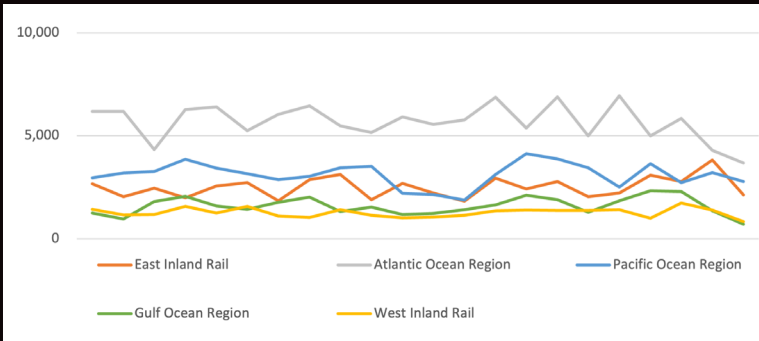

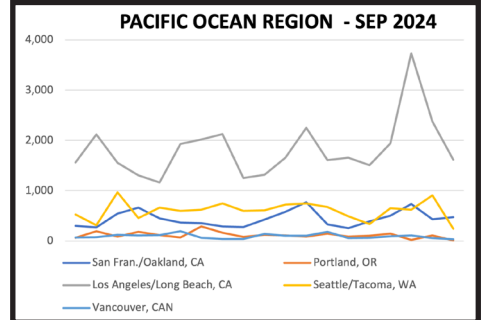
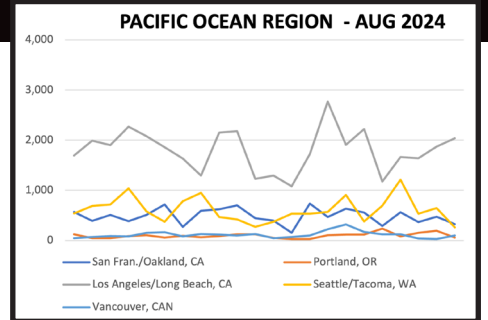
SUMMARY – OCTOBER 2024

Due to the commencement of the ILA strike on the East and Gulf Coasts, both regions have been moved to SEVERE. All operations and equipment will be adversely affected. It should be noted that—just as during Covid crisis—there will not be a significant impact felt during the strike, but once operations recommence after the strike ends. Congestion, lack of equipment / yard space, capacity constrictions, and vessel congestion will all stress all supply chains. As was seen during the days leading up to the strike, driver productivity dropped significantly. Drivers that could pull 6 containers or more per day prior were only able to get 1-2 containers per day out of the port. Shippers should be prepared to add a minimum of 3-5x drivers to their current network. It should be noted that for every 36 hours the ports are closed, port operations will be negatively impacted for 1 week.

- On the West Coast, significant volume increases—as a result of Red Sea diversions and diverted volumes to avoid the US East/Gulf Coasts—have stressed chassis, driver, and yard availability. This will continue until West Coast volumes subside.
- West Coast rail operations are being tested due to IPI volumes that have increased as volumes from the East/Gulf Coast are diverted to avoid ILA strike activity.
- Export availability on the East and Gulf Coast have been closed due to strike activity. This will add to congestion prior to, and after, the strike.

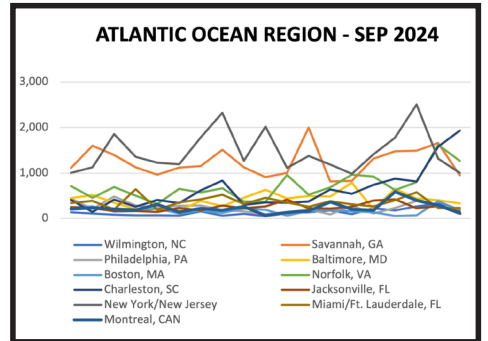
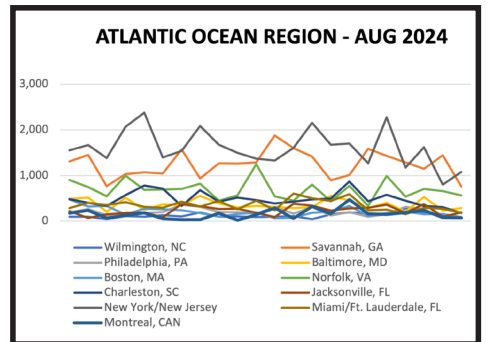
OPPORTUNITY FOR OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY – For containers arriving to the US West Coast destined for IPI rail legs, move to dray-off, transload, and one-way trucking while capacity still exists.

OPERATIONAL INTERRUPTION – Chassis pools and container storage availability—especially in LA/LB—are starting to see signs of stress on the US West Coast. Ensure your provider has chassis availability outside of the POP yards and procure additional container storage yard space.

EXPORT OPERATIONS – East/Gulf Coast diverted volumes will stress West Coast export operations as volumes are diverted.

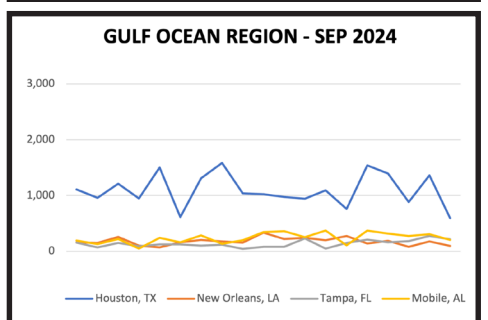
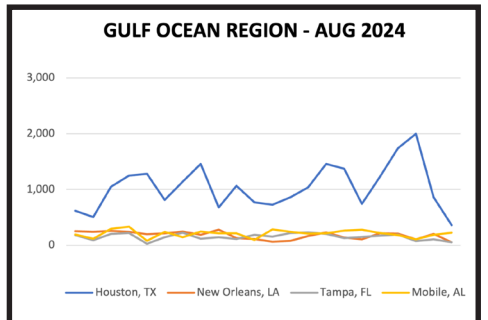
OPPORTUNITY FOR OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY – Add additional capacity and transportation providers immediately.

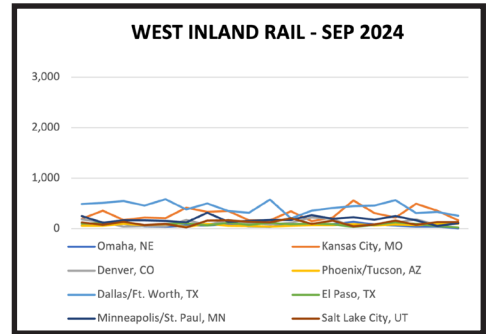
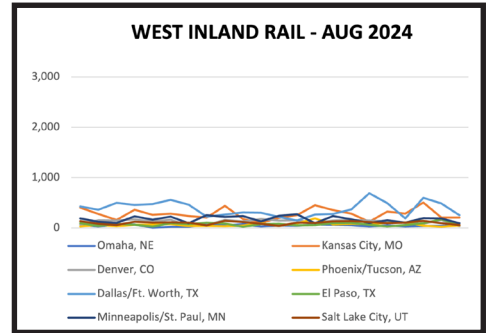

OPPORTUNITY FOR OPERATIONAL EFFICIENCY – Set up dray-off, transload, and one-way trucking operations for import traffic off the West Coast.

OPERATIONAL INTERRUPTION – With IPI in higher demand to get freight to the US East/Gulf Coast, expect longer transit time and delays.

EXPORT OPERATIONS – Expect additional congestion due to volumes diverting from the East/Gulf Coast.



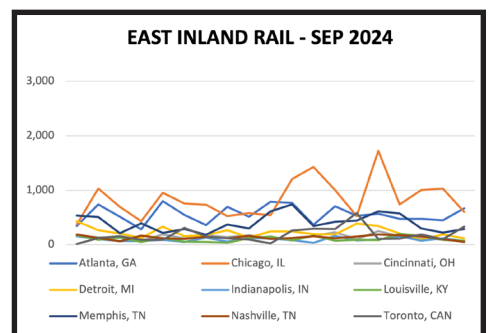
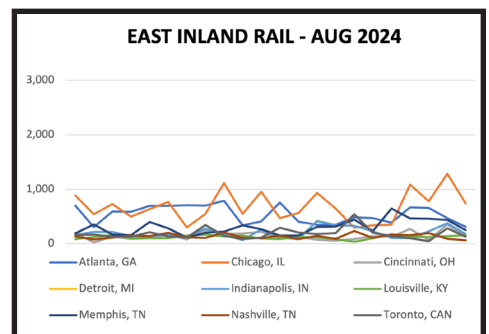

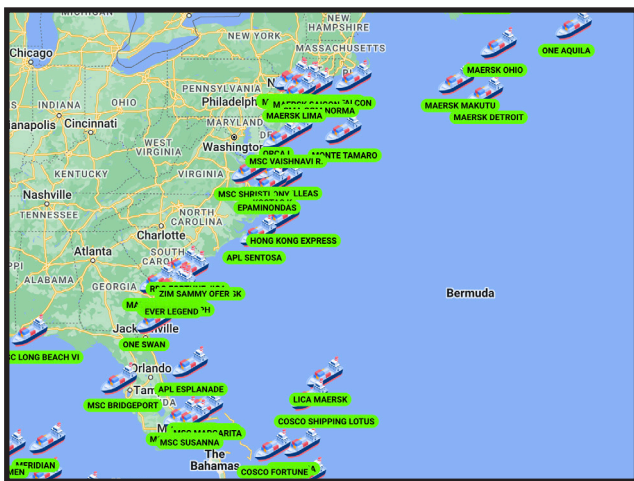
CONTAINER INSIDER ADVANTAGE

Visibility platform access is going to be crucial during strike activity on the US East/Gulf Coast. CAI will show when appointments are made, where containers are located, and changing ETAs as vessels are anchored awaiting to discharge containers. There is also a high likelihood that containers may be discharged at ports/terminals they were not originally scheduled to.

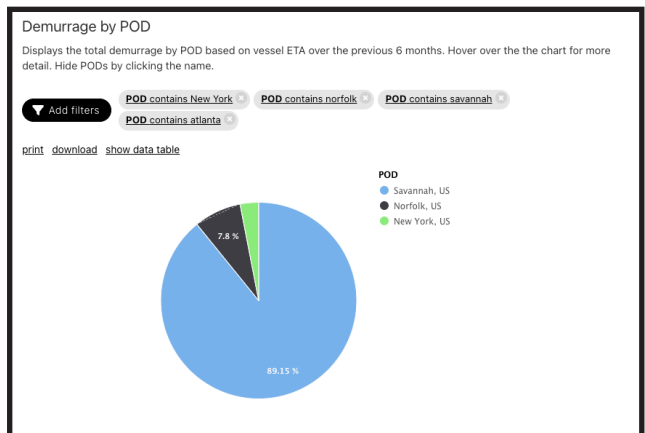
CAI can also store all data points and documentation, so a shipper can dispute what is certain to be extremely excessive demurrage and per diem charges.
